It's very hard to believe, but January 28, 2024, will mark the 5-year anniversary of the untimely, senseless death of our beloved son, brother, uncle, cousin, and friend, Jordan Radway. While our family continues to mourn this devastating loss, we have channeled our grief into carrying on the loving and positive energy Jordan exuded in this world. Through establishing and operating Jordan's Way Foundation, a 503(c) organization, we are making a positive impact in our community.

We are so very proud of the success we have had with our flagship program, The Jordan's Way Foundation Scholarship Program. It's because of donors like you, that Jordan's Way Foundation has had the good fortune of being able to award \$21,000 in scholarships to 14 amazing high school seniors graduating from the high schools in the Montgomery County, MD Northeast Consortium.

We have also been able to provide support to other non-profit organizations with similar missions of helping to end gun violence in our nation and especially among our youth. This year, we supported and participated in the Gun Violence Awareness Bridge Walk hosted by DMV Mothers Like Me, a non-profit established and operating by Donna Haynes. DMV Mothers Like Me works to provide information on resources for gun violence survivors and their families as they navigate through the process of recovery. Jordan's Way Foundation also continued to provide financial support to March for Our Lives as they continue to fight against gun violence. In October, we supported the Christian Roberts Foundation by attending their Sneaker Ball Fundraiser event. Jordan's Way Foundation Executives, Tina and Peter Radway were among the Christian Roberts Foundation 2023 Overcomers Award Recipients.
